

2018-19 DESTINATION IMAGINATION VIRGINIA HARRY HANCOCK SCHOLARSHIP



The DI Virginia Board of Directors will offer scholarships this season to students planning on attending a college or university next year. To be eligible, you must have participated in the Destination Imagination Virginia program for at least one year and you may NOT have already received a scholarship from DI Virginia. To apply, complete and send in the following:

1. **The Application Form:** <https://tinyurl.com/DIVASS2019>
2. **Two Letters of Recommendation:** Only one of each of the following letters of recommendation will be considered. If more are submitted, the Scholarship Committee will arbitrarily select one of each letter, which may not offer the strongest support. All letters of recommendation should be emailed directly to scholarship@divirginia.org.
 - **One letter of recommendation from a Team Manager or a DI coordinator** limited to 500 words. A letter of recommendation from a family member is acceptable if that family member is the best person to speak to your involvement in DI.
 - **One letter of recommendation from a school official** (principal, vice-principal, instructor or advisor/counselor), limited to 500 words.
3. **A Creative Response** to the following prompt:

At the end of a long day preparing your Team Challenge solution, you realize your team has made an unbelievable mess. You need to clean it up before your Team Manager gets back! You may use the following materials to clean up the mess:

 - 1 lamp
 - 10 Feet of Roller Coaster Track
 - 1 Object that Could Be Found in Space
 - 1 Object that is Made of Paper

In your response, include the materials you would use and describe how you would clean up the mess. Your response must be able to fit on one side of one 8.5 x11 inch sheet of paper, whether you submit it physically or digitally. Follow the submission guidelines below.
4. **A “Creative Picture of You”** Here is your chance to be creative! We want to know about YOU and how Destination Imagination and creative problem solving has influenced your life and your outlook. Choose one of the following formats to best convey this “Creative Picture of You.” Follow the submission guidelines below.
 - **Audio file:** limited to 5 minutes
 - **Visual presentation:** Slideshow limited to 25 slides or video limited to 5 minutes
 - **Written Story, Poem, or Essay:** double spaced and limited to 1000 words
 - **Internet Content:** must be submitted in a form distributable via the Internet (i.e. free of intellectual property infringements and viewable with a standard browser.)
 - **Have another idea?** Great! Go for it!

Submission Guidelines for the Creative Picture of You and the Creative Response:

Option 1: Digital: Email any digital submissions to scholarship@divirginia.org. Submissions may be sent as email attachments, hyperlinks to external websites, or google drive links.

Option 2: Physical: Mail 6 copies of any physical submissions to the address below. All physical submissions must fit within a 9x12 manila envelope.
